1. Body (Yarn Used: Lavender, Milk Tea Brown and Cup White)

Start with Lavender color yarn

- R1: 6 sc in magic ring [6 sts]
- R2: 6 inc [12 sts]
- R3: (inc, sc) x 6 times [18 sts]
- R4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 times [24 sts]
- R5: (inc, 3sc) x 6 times [30 sts]
- R6: (2sc, inc, 2sc) x 6 times [36 sts]
- R7: blo 36 sc [36 sts]
- R8-10: 36 sc [36 sts]
- R11: (17 sc, inc) x 2 times [38 sts]
- R12: 38 sc [38 sts]
- R13: 8sc, inc, 18sc, inc, 10sc [40 sts]
- R14: 40sc [40sts]
- R15: (19 sc, inc) x 2 times [42 sts]



Change to milk tea color yarn

- R16-18: (42sc [42 sts]
- R19: 10sc, inc, 20sc, inc, 10sc [44 sts]
- R20: 44sc [44 sts]
- R21: (21sc, inc) x 2 times [46sts]
- R22: 46sc [46 sts]
- R23: 11sc, inc, 22sc, inc, 11sc [48 sts]



Change to cup white yarn

- R24: 48sc [48 sts]
- R25: flo, 48sc [48sts]
- R26: 48dc [48sts]



F/O

Fill with the stuffing.



2. Whipped cream top (Yarn Used: Foam White)

R1: 6 sc in magic ring [6 sts]
R2: 6 sc [6 sts]
R3: flo, 6 inc [12 sts]
R4: 12sc [12sts]
R5: flo, (sc, inc) x 6 times [18 sts]
R6: 18sc [18 sts]
R7: (sc, inc, sc) x 6 times [24 sts]
R8: flo, (3 sc, inc) x 6 times [30 sts]
R9: (4 sc, inc) x 6 times [36 sts]
R10: (5 sc, inc) x 6 times [42 sts]
R11: 42sc [42 sts]
R12: 10 sc, inc, 20sc, inc, 10sc [44 sts]
F/o Leaving a long tail for stitching to body.

Fill with the stuffing.



3. Hands and feet x 4 (Yarn Used: Warm Tan)

R1: 6 sc in magic ring [6 sts]
R2: 6inc [12 sts]
R3: 6 dec [6 sts]

Fill with the stuffing.
F/o - Pull to close



4. Arms x 2 (Yarn Used: Warm Tan)

R1: 3 sc in magic ring [3 sts]
R2-6: 3 sc [3 sts]
F/o leaving a tail for later stitching.



Connect arms and hands,
insert 5cm iron wire.

F/o - Pull to close



5. Legs x 2 (Yarn Used: Warm Tan)

R1: 3 sc in magic ring [3 sts]

R2-3: 3 sc [3 sts]

F/o leaving a tail for later stitching.

Connect feet and legs,
insert 4cm iron wire

F/o - Pull to close



6. Straw (Yarn Used: Warm Tan)

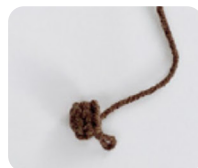
R1: 6 sc in magic ring [6 sts]

R2: blo, 6 sc [6 sts]

R3-8: 6 sc [6 sts].

Fill with the stuffing

The ASSEMBLY



REMINDER



Your **Stitch Heart** is extra special before you close your creation, hold it tight, make a wish, or send it some good energy. Then place it inside the stuffing to make your character truly one-of-a-kind!

1. Install Eyes

1. Poke the black eyes through the front of the Milk Tea stitching. Position them approximately 2-3 rows down from the start of the white stitching and about 6-7 stitches apart.
2. Secure in place by firmly attaching the clear backing clip to each of the eyes from the inside of the body.



2. Whipped cream Top to the Body

1. Place the filled whipped cream top piece on top of the stuffing filled body.
2. Thread the needle onto the tail that was left on the whipped cream top piece and sew around attaching to the body.



3. Sew on Straw

1. Position the straw to on the top right side of the whipped cream piece.
2. Thread the needle onto the tail that was left on the straw piece and sew around attaching it to the whipped cream.



4. Sew on the Arms

1. Position the arms to each side of the body around the height of where the colour changes from Lavender to Milk Tea Brown.
2. Thread the needle onto the tail that was left on the arm pieces and sew around attaching them to the body.



5. Sew on the Legs

1. Position the legs to the base of the lavender body leaving 3-4 stitches in between.
2. Thread the needle onto the tail that was left on the leg pieces and sew around attaching them to the body.



6. Embroidering the Pearls and the Face

THE PEARLS

1. Thread the needle with the pearl black yarn.
2. Bring the needle from the back of the body to the front around the middle of the lavender section.
3. Use small straight stitches to outline a circle.
(TIP: FOLLOW THE NATURAL HOLES OR STITCHES OF THE CROCHET TO KEEP IT NEAT.)
4. Stitch back and forth across the circle with straight stitches, keeping stitches close together.
5. Add a few stitches at slight angles to fill gaps and make the ball look round.
6. Continue to create more pearls all around the bottom of the body in the lower half of the lavender section.



THE MOUTH

1. Bring the needle up centered between and slightly below the eyes.
2. Insert the needle back into the Boba body 2-3 stitches below and diagonally right to start the curvy line (mouth start).
3. Insert the needle back into the Boba body 2-3 stitches above and diagonally right then back up 2-3 stitches above and diagonally left to complete the long curvy line.
4. Secure yarn at the back and weave in ends.



ROSY CHEEKS

1. Thread the needle with blush pink yarn.
2. Insert the needle just below the left eye.
3. Repeat steps 3-5 for pearls to create a rosy cheek.
4. Repeat the same for the other cheek.
5. Secure yarn at the back and weave in ends.
